## Scripture 2

**Matthew.21:9-11** “The crowds that went ahead of Him and those that followed, shouted, “Hosanna to the Son of David, Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord, Hosanna in the highest.” When Jesus entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred (moved) and asked, “Who is this?” The crowds answered, “This is Jesus, the prophet from Nazareth in Galilee.” **NIV**

## Scripture 3

**John 12:12-13**, “The next day a great multitude that had come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, took branches of palm trees and went out to meet Him, and cried out: “Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD! Blessed is The King of Israel!” **NIV**

**John 14:27** “Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you, not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid”

**Matthew 11:28** “Come to Me, all you who labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest”;

## Scripture 4

**Zechariah 9:9** “Rejoice greatly, O Daughter of Zion! Shout, Daughter of Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and having salvation, gentle and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.”

## Scripture 5

**Mark 11:1-11** Now when they drew near Jerusalem, to Bethphage and Bethany, at the Mount of Olives, He sent two of His disciples; **2** and He said to them, “Go into the village opposite you; and as soon as you have entered it you will find a colt tied, on which no one has sat. Loose it and bring it. **3** And if anyone says to you, ‘Why are you doing this?’ say, ‘The Lord has need of it,’ and immediately he will send it here.” **4** So they went their way, and found the colt tied by the door outside on the street, and they loosed it. **5** But some of those who stood there said to them, “What are you doing, loosing the colt?” **6** And they spoke to them just as Jesus had commanded. So they let them go.

## Scripture 6

**Mark 11:1-11 (cont.)** **7** Then they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their clothes on it, and He sat on it. **8** And many spread their clothes on the road, and others cut down leafy branches from the trees and spread them on the road. **9** Then those who went before and those who followed cried out, saying: “Hosanna! ‘Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD!’ **10** Blessed is the kingdom of our father David That comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!” **11** And Jesus went into Jerusalem and into the temple. So when He had looked around at all things, as the hour was already late, He went out to Bethany with the twelve.
